## Lalique Group applies for delisting of its shares

Zurich, 29 July 2024 - Lalique Group SA (SIX: LLQ), which is active in the creation, development, marketing and worldwide distribution of luxury goods, has applied to SIX Exchange Regulation for the delisting of Lalique Group shares following the completion of Silvio Denz's public tender offer.

After the voluntary public tender offer by Silvio Denz for all publicly held registered shares of Lalique Group (with the exception of the shares of those shareholders who had undertaken not to tender their shares into the offer) was completed as planned on July 19, 2024, Lalique Group has submitted an application to SIX Exchange Regulation for the delisting of its shares.
